The Covid1 9 outbreak in Thailand tends to be stable but not in decline, the number of patients who are severely ill and dependent on ventilators is rising.

Order of the Center of COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA), asking for pubic cooperation on Covid-1 9 vaccination participation, wearing face masks whenever they leave their residences, social distancing for at least 1 meter away from each other. It is now mandatory to wear a face mask when outside your home in all provinces, under regulations to contain the spread of Covid-19. The fine for mask violations was set at up to 20,000 baht, but for first-time offenders it would start at 6,000 baht and gradually increase on subsequent offences. In addition, curfews are now in force in many provinces.

The Medical Association of Thailand comprehends your situation; it is the time for the Nepal people to take responsibility as the country need your strength to transform your acts, thoughts, intentions to fight against the Covid19 under the "Hami Ek Chhau" Unity is Immunity campaign. Let love and kindness be on your courage path.
