


COUNTRY REPORT

Pakistan Medical Association (PMA) was established in 1948. PMA has country wide 120 branches. The organization is composed on Centre, Provinces and District / Regions.







Pakistan Medical Association (PMA) always offers recommendations and places charter of demands for the government to implement to improve the healthcare system in Pakistan. In this regard PMA issued a report, to media, on 31st December 2020 on major health issues and burden of different diseases. The report is being issued every year that presents the critical analysis of the health situation during the whole year.

The report was widely covered by the press and media.

Covid situation in Pakistan

 The pandemic reached Pakistan in February 2020. The first two cases of COVID-19 were confirmed by Health Authorities on February 26th. Both patients had history of travelling to Iran. Till March 12 the tally of the Coronavirus patients reached to 21, all having history of travelling abroad. The first case of local transmission was reported on 13th March in Karachi. Now till August 12, 2021 the tally of the total confirmed cases in Pakistan has reached to 1,085,294 and the death toll is 24,187.

From the very first day when coronavirus erupted in China and the number of death tool then just rose to six, PMA through a press release on 22-01-2020 came out with the suggestion to government to take up some urgent steps to avoid spread of coronavirus in Pakistan. We suggested the government to install thermal scanners at our International Airports and at every entry points of our international borders to scan the passengers arriving from high risk countries. Through the press release we also suggested to establish quarantine facilities at airports and border entries to quarantine the people found with symptoms for two weeks. If somebody is found positive for coronavirus we should have Isolation facilities in the country to keep and treat the patients.



Covid-19 situation in Pakistan

On January 22nd, 2020 PMA through media also issued the preventive guidelines for public to make them aware, how by taking few preventive steps they can keep themselves save from Coronavirus.

After that PMA is consistently involved in providing suggestions and guidelines to government and public to overcome the spread of covid-19 in the country.


