Public health related activities

Social awareness programs against tobacco & related health hazards:-

BMA jointly organized scientific seminar with National Heart Foundation Bangladesh on 26th July 2022. A good number of front line journalist & social activist were present in that meeting. In this seminar different stakeholders who are dedicated in the activities against tobacco were joined & delivered their valuable opinions. Another same program will be held in two divisional cities on next October'2022. The program title was "Achieving Tobacco free Bangladesh by 2040: Celebrating hand work's road ahead" which was organized for Tobacco free Kids.

Campaigning program to prevent Dengue & Chikungunya infection in Bangladesh:-

BMA organized several rallies, scientific seminar regarding Ades mosquito control to prevent Dengue infection and its complications. BMA also published leaflets, posters regarding Dengue prevention and distributed to public in Dhaka City as well as all around the countries.



Public health related activities contd...

The role of combating COVID-19 situation in Bangladesh:

Bangladesh was affected by 1st COVID-19 infection on 18th March 2020. Before that Bangladesh Medical Association (BMA) organized a Scientific Seminar on prevention & control of COVID-19 infection & its complications in BMA Bhaban where Health Minister of Bangladesh, renowned virologist & renowned physicians of Bangladesh were present. From there we developed national protocol & submitted to DGHS. Same program were hold in different Institutions, Medical Colleges & districts in Bangladesh which were also organized by BMA.



Public health related activities contd...

• At the beginning of COVID-19 infection BMA nominated 500 volunteer doctors to provide treatment for the COVID-19 patients in Bangladesh. There are around two millions of people infected by COVID-19 in Bangladesh & related death were 29,339.

• The doctors & other health professionals gave services dedicated to COVID-19 patients. And at that time around 8000 doctors and other health professional were affected by COVID-19 infection & more than 200 doctors sacrificed their life to fight against COVID-19.



Ethical issues & Law related with health professionals

Ethics & law related health issues in Bangladesh:

 Bangladesh Medical Association (BMA) jointly organized a workshop with National Heart Foundation of Bangladesh, on 1st November 2021 at BMA Bhaban to make an amendment of law against tobacco and related noncommunicable diseases. Renowned cardiologists, pulmonologists, physicians, journalists and a contingent of young doctors who are serving around the root levels of the country were present in that program. From that workshop we put some amendment of existing law regarding tobacco use in the country.



Ethics & law related health issues in Bangladesh contd...

• We worked with the ministry of health and parliamentary standing committee to prepare a "Mental Health Regulatory Law" which will help in treating a vast number of population who are suffering mental health issues in the country. This law will provide a protection to serving healthcare professionals.

Ethics & law related health issues in Bangladesh contd...

• Bangladesh Medical Association (BMA) is intimately working with the ministry of health, ministry of law, and health parliamentary standing committee to formulate a law regarding the protection of doctors and health professionals and also service recipients. As we all know that the health care professionals round the globe are randomly abused and occasionally assaulted. It is a huge concern of health care delivery system in Bangladesh.

Research & Publications

• **Research & Publication**: We are regularly publishing BMA Journal which is icon journal for the doctor's community in our country. Renowned professors, researchers and specialists are contributing their legendary efforts and discovering to that journal. Sixty Seven branches of our organization around the country are publishing their branch Journal regularly. All these journals are kept in different prominent library of medical colleges, institutions and universities, even we are trying to handover the journal to all member of BMA. These Journals enrich the recent updates in the field of modern health science to all doctors.

- Recently our honorable Prime Minister incessantly encouraging the doctor's community to engage themselves in research activities. She is allocated a huge amount of money for research purpose.
- Bangladesh Medical Research Council (BMRC) and Bangladesh Medical Association are taking lead in this research activities. Very recently a group of doctors engage themselves to develop Corona Vaccine.

• Our President & Secretary General are the member of high level health related policy making issues of Ministry of Health and Parliamentary Standing Committee of Health.

Social welfare activities

Social Activities:

- We are arranging "Free Friday health care delivery" for the needy people in every Friday of Calendar year. Specialist doctors are examining the patients & providing necessary drugs for the patients.
- We engaged doctors and related health professionals for the HAZI (Pilgrims) every year in their camp.
- We had emergency medical team all over the country who is taking part in health care delivery system during flood & any disaster.
- We distribute winter clothes & blankets to poor community of the country.

Education & Training

• We arranged regular training program on Diabetes, Cardiac Disease, Malaria, Dengue, COVID-19 & other health issues for doctors & health professionals.

• At present training program on Diabetes & common hormonal diseases is going on as a joint venture of Bangladesh Medical Association (BMA) & Bangladesh Endocrine Society (BES).
