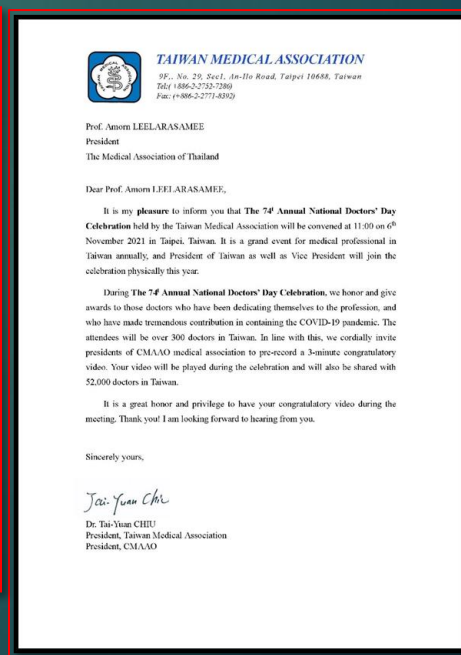

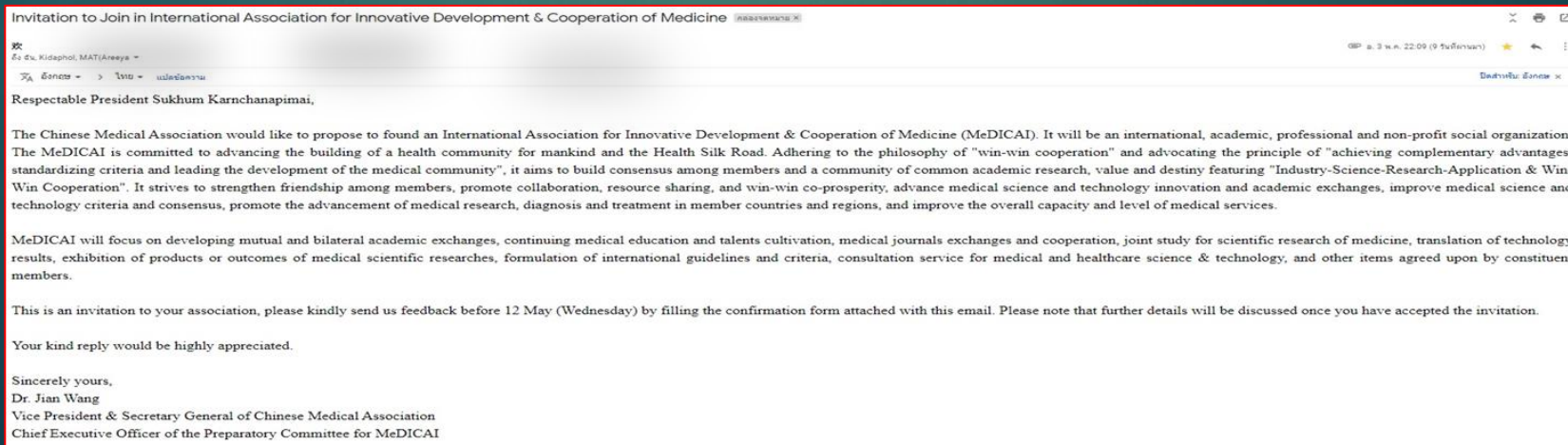

"Clean Air Day "

Clean Air is undoubtedly a prime need for the living of all human beings. Clean air must have no smell, colorless and tasteless. It must contain no pollutant, no particulate materials, and no chemicals. Pollution in the air can be contributed by natural burning such as wildfire but unfortunately, most of the air pollution was caused by human, manmade, such as cooking, traffic, industries, power stations and worst of all is the habit of tobacco smoking which is the most concentrated inhalation of burning pollution. Tobacco smoke contains not only particulate materials but also more than one thousand chemicals and heavy metals which are cancerogenic and causative of several chronic diseases which burden and shorten lives.

The Medical Association of Thailand has been actively working in supporting the "Clean Air Project" in collaboration with the Ministry of Public Health and the Thai Health Promotion Bureau in the processing of the Smoking Cessation Program. With the support of the Thai Government, the "Tobacco Product Control Enactment" has been affected since 2017. This new enactment is a combination of the tobacco control law and the nonsmoker rights protection. It prohibits smoking in close public spaces, transportation, schools, universities, marketplaces etc.

Physicians are acting as leaders of the smoking cessation program to promote public health. With this project, less smokers in public spaces and less cigarette butts are observed on the road and pavement.

All these attempts are one aspect for the Clean Air and healthy lives.

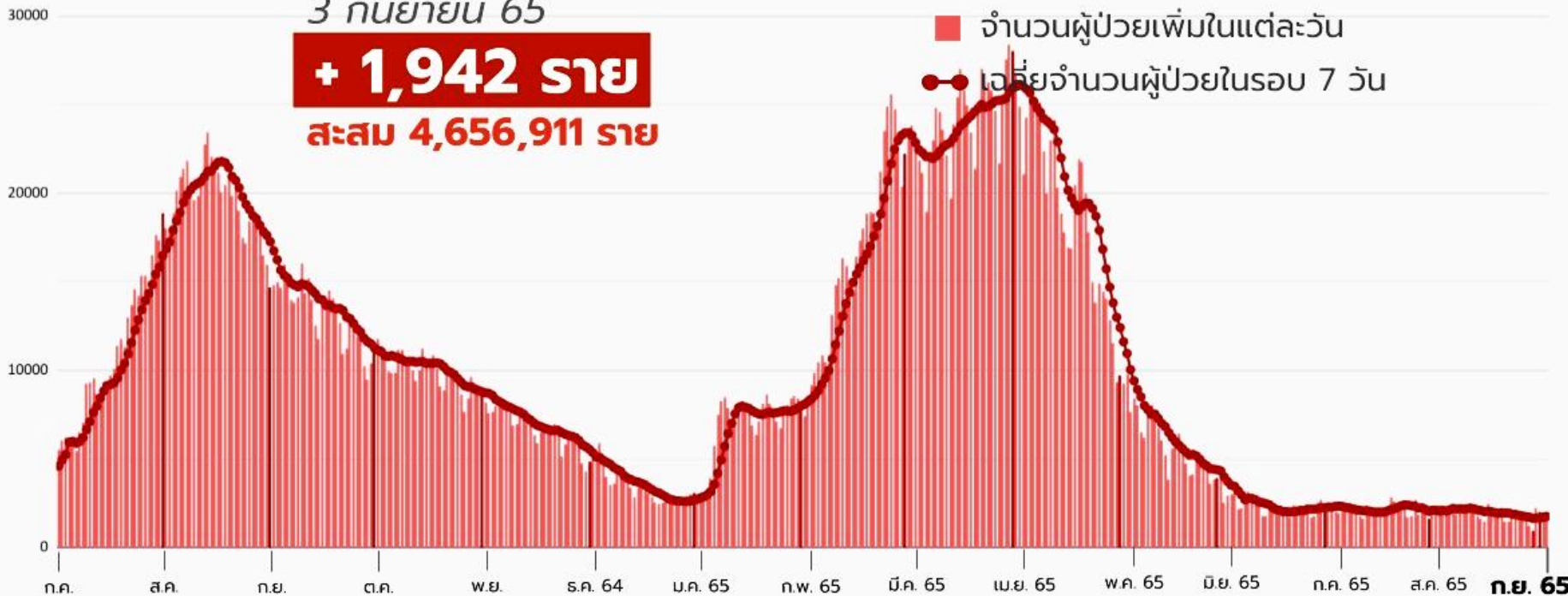

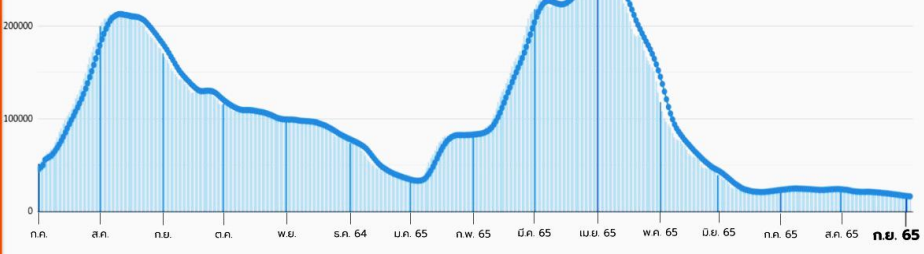

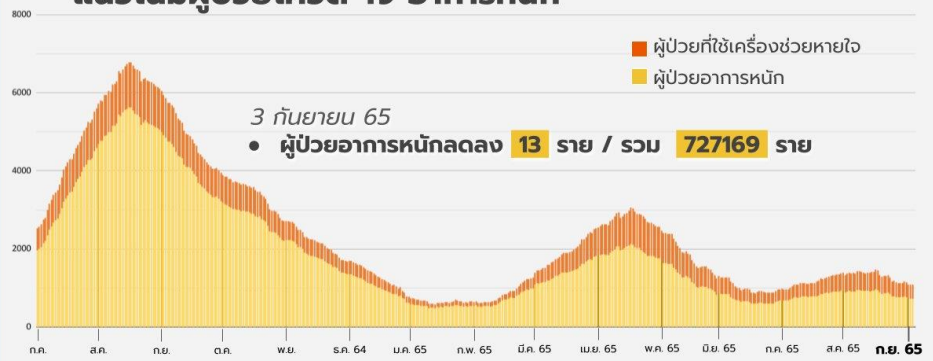

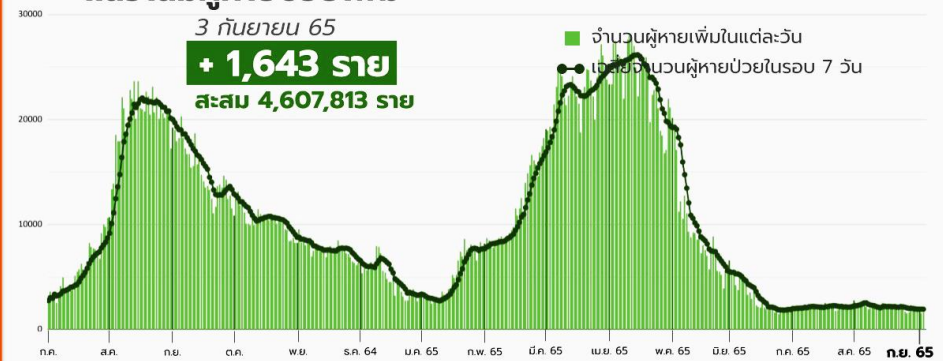
