


Advocating for Patients and the Profession

Health Insurance

SMA continued its work on the Multilateral Healthcare Insurance Committee (MHIC). These measures seek to improve patient access to care, and also reduce the administrative workload for doctors so that they may better focus their efforts on patient care.

Welfare of Junior Doctors

- Doctors-in-Training Committee continued to lobby for sustainable working conditions of junior doctors in public healthcare institutions in the past year.

 The Office of the Public Guardian (OPG) launched the OPG Online (OPGO) system – an online platform to facilitate transactions with the OPG.


Certifying LPA under the Mental Capacity Act – Understanding the Issues and Avoiding the Pitfalls

Singapore Medical Journal



In 2022, the Singapore Medical Journal (SMJ) achieved several major milestones:

- 1. A historic impact factor (IF) of 3.331, moving the *SMJ* up in the "Medicine, General and Internal" category from the third to the second quartile (Journal Citation Reports, Clarivate 2022).
- 2. SMJ's transition in July 2022 to partnering with a publisher, Wolters Kluwer Medknow.
- 3. The transition of the *SMJ* to an online-only journal, and the December 2022 issue marked the final time that the journal was distributed as a print copy.
